
## **How To Add Fonts IOS**







After you have the app, go to one of the font websites and download a font. I went to dafont.com and downloaded 'Jackster"
After it downloads tap the little blue arrow



On the next screen tap the zip file of the font you just downloaded.




This will create a new folder with your font in it. Tap on it to open it.




Once the folder is open tap select at the top and then select the .otf or .ttf file that contains the font. After it's selected you'll need to tap the square with an arrow pointing up to open the menu.



On the next screen scroll over until you see the more button and tap on that.



Now scroll down through the apps until you see COPY TO iFONT and tap on that.



## How To Add Fonts IOS Cont.







On the next screen locate the font you downloaded and tap install.




Next the app will give have a tutorial on installing fonts. Scroll through until you get to the screen where you'll tap allow.



Then you will see that the profile is downloaded. Tap close, exit the app and then open your phone's settings app.




In the settings app tap on profile downloaded



tap install and then enter your passcode when prompted.

Then tap install on the top and tap install again on the bottom. Your font is now installed.
